For many, the holidays are a time of family, food, faith, fun, and traditions. But nearly 10 percent of all Cudahy and St. Francis residents struggle with purchasing basic necessities, such as food, clothing and personal care items.

Project Concern's Thanksgiving food box and Christmas

toy program for children ensure that families can make their holidays memorable with a hearty meal and gifts.

Project Concern volunteers pack approximately 85 food boxes, which contain Thanksgiving meal items including a turkey, stuffing mix, mashed potatoes, combread, vegetables and dessert! These boxes are then distributed to families that are in need.

Families with children 17 and under can sign up for the Christmas toy program to receive an age-appropriate gift.

# Volunteer Spotlight: Meet Missie!

Volunteer and Project Concern Marketing Director Missie Beaber first discovered Project Concern and its services after a friend recommended she try its medical lending library for equipment needed after undergoing surgery.

Volunteer Pat Mull, who oversees the lending library, helped her find what she needed. "She was phenomenal," Missie recalled.

She felt a connection with the pantry as soon as she walked through its doors. "I thought, 'I have to come back here.' I felt that I could be a part of something and make a difference."

Although the pantry had a waiting list for volunteers at the time, Missie was soon able to fill a front desk position, and now volunteers several shifts a week. "It's the best," she said. "We get to love like Jesus, one person at a time. I feel like we are just a big family--everyone is so kind and dedicated."

Missie, a Kenosha native who has experience in nonprofit fund development and marketing, along with a degree in communications from Parkside University and a marketing degree from Gateway Technical College, was offered the position of Project Concern Marketing Director in July 2024. Her duties include social media management, community outreach, creating graphics, and more.

As someone whose own family visited food pantries when she was a child, Missie encourages community members to examine their assumptions about people who visit the Project Concern pantry. "They look just like us—they are our neighbors," she added. "So many people don't have the support system that we have—we get to be their community."

# **Classic Sweet Potato Casserole**

## Ingredients:

- 3 cups mashed sweet potatoes
- 1/2 cup sugar
- 2 beaten eggs
- 1/4 cup butter, melted
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 1/2 teaspoons vanilla
- Toppings:
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1/3 cup flour
- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1/3 cup butter, melted

## **Directions:**

Mix sweet potatoes, sugar, eggs, butter, milk and vanilla. Pour into 9 inch square greased baking dish. Mix topping ingredients and sprinkle over potatoes. Bake at 350 degrees for 35-40 minutes.


